ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Penalty Notice Fines

- unauthorised term time holiday -

The LA Penalty Notice code of conduct has been amended to take into account the Supreme Court Judgement (**Isle of Wight v John Platt**) which clarified the meaning of "regular" school attendance as outlined in Section 444 Education Act 1996. Penalty Notice fines can now be issued for **single event absences** of at least 3 consecutive school days or more where these absences are unauthorised because they are neither exceptional nor unavoidable. **A penalty notice fine is £60 per child, per parent.** Please do not book holidays during term times.
