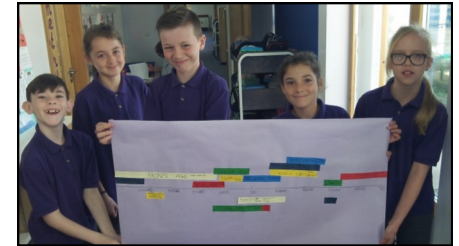

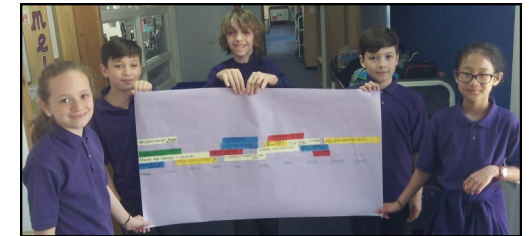

MUSICIAN OF THE WEEK

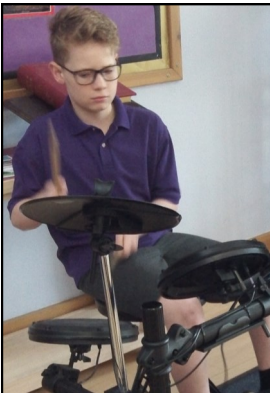
Our MUSICIAN of the week is Oscar Y6. He entertained us by playing 'Come Together' on the drums.
